Honors students must maintain an overall GPA of at least a 3.2.

Freshman

Complete 6 credit hours of honors courses by enrolling in one 3 credit hour honors course each semester

Junior

Complete 6 credit hours of honors courses by enrolling in one 3 credit hour honors course each semester

Senior

Design and complete a supervised interdisciplinary project consisting of a written thesis and oral presentation. This project receives 6 credit hours upon completion.
