How to enroll in Maymester

1. *What classes are available?*

Review the course schedule and complete the registration form in the Registrar's Office. Submit form to Registrar or Michael Drew in the Welcome Center.

2. *Do you have financial aid from the previous academic year?*

To find out, contact the Office of Financial Aid for assistance. Federal Direct and Plus loans are only available to students taking six hours or more during the summer. Read more about financial aid below.

3. *Do we have your FAFSA on file?*

If you do not already have a 2016-2017 FAFSA on file in the Office of Financial Aid and want to apply for aid, go to www.fafsa.ed.gov and complete FAFSA. Use Wesleyan's school code of 002951. A FAFSA must be on file in the Office of Financial Aid prior to the first day of classes - May 1.

Financial Aid

Summer financial aid at NC Wesleyan College consists of federal aid and private education loans. Applicants for federal aid must be degree-seeking Wesleyan students. Visiting students cannot receive federal aid. Applicants for Federal Direct and PLUS loans must enroll in at least six hours during the summer.

Students intending to apply for federal aid should have a 2016-17 FAFSA (School Code 002951) on file with the Office of Financial Aid prior to the first day of classes. Federal aid is limited to remaining academic year eligibility (if any) for Pell Grants, Perkins Loans, Direct Loans, and PLUS Loans. Federal aid applicants must meet satisfactory academic progress requirements. A student who begins attendance in all classes during a summer term is awarded aid based on the enrollment status at the time of disbursement, even if his or her enrollment status changes subsequently. A student who withdraws from all courses is subject to the return of aid funds.

Housing

Summer housing will be available in single rooms on campus at a rate of \$300 per month. Space is limited and available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
