Transfer Requirements

- 12 transferrable college credits (Course level typically 100 or above; Must have at least a C in each course)
- GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Provide an official transcript from each post-secondary institution attended.
- Demonstrate good standing in all post-secondary institutions attended.
- Students transferring with the AA/AS from the NC Community College System are considered to have all general education requirements met. For students transferring prior to receiving the AA/AS or from schools outside the NCCCS, transcripts will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
- A student with fewer than 12 transferrable college credits must apply as a freshman.

Transfer Scholarships

Award	Award Value	GPA Requirement
Transfer Gold	\$13,500	3.5+
Transfer Blue	\$10,500	3.0-3.4
Transfer White	\$7,500	2.5-2.9

- 2+Wesleyan Scholarship \$2,000 - Must have an associate degree with an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship \$1,000
- United Methodist Scholarship \$2,000 - Must be a member of the United Methodist Church and submit a letter of reference from pastor.
- Eagle Scout Scholarship \$1,000
- Additional scholarships are available for band, drama, cheer/dance, and choir. Auditions are required.
- Transfer scholarships are renewed annually, require fulltime enrollment, and a 2.0 or higher in college coursework.
- Legacy Scholarship \$22,000* (resident) or \$18,000* (commuter) - Eligible only if parent or grandparent graduated from NC Wesleyan.

*Award replaces all other institutional aid.



Financial Aid

- 100% of NCWC students receive financial aid. Institutional aid is awarded based on academic performance, enrollment classification, housing status and financial need.
- Complete your FAFSA (Free Application for Student Aid) and use school code 002951.
- Military Discount: All active duty and veterans of all branches of the military, including the National Guard and Coast Guard, receive a 10% discount. This discount will be applied as an internal grant towards the cost of attending after the drop/add period. The discount is for students only (excludes family members).
