**My.NCWC.edu:** All students must use my.ncwc.edu for class syllabus and assignments, college announcements, teacher communication, and report cards. See staff for login information or call the helpdesk at 252-984-5000.

**Syllabus:** Will be posted one week before class starts. Retrieve a copy of your course syllabus through [my.ncwc.edu](http://my.ncwc.edu), click on “My Courses” and then each individual course. Remember that courses have assignments due on the first night.

**Tuition:** *\$355 per semester hour* (2018-2019) for online and seated courses.

**Attendance:** Students are required to attend all classes. In the event of an absence, the student is responsible for notifying the instructor ahead of time. Missing more than twenty percent of a course could result in a failing grade.

**Drop Dates:** Students must drop the course by the Tuesday after the first week of class in order to receive a full tuition refund (all sessions start on a Monday, regardless of the day the class actually starts). You may be able to replace a dropped course with another course in the same session, depending on the instructor’s approval. Classes must be dropped before the fourth night to receive a W. Students are required to submit a drop form. A course cannot be withdrawn after midpoint.

**Textbook Ordering:** If you are using financial aid to order textbooks, complete a Book Voucher and submit it to Fabiola Kinney at [fkinney@ncwc.edu](mailto:fkinney@ncwc.edu). Students can only submit Book Vouchers for each session at a time.

**Financial Aid:** Remember to track your financial aid on [my.ncwc.edu](http://my.ncwc.edu) and submit any missing documents. Please email ReOtis Anderson at [randerson@ncwc.edu](mailto:randerson@ncwc.edu) if you have any questions or concerns regarding your financial aid.

**Tutoring:** Online tutoring is available 24 hours a day with SmartThinking! You can access this through [my.ncwc.edu](http://my.ncwc.edu). If you are having difficulties with writing, math or other subjects, log in today for one-on-one tutoring, real-time help or just to ask a question.

**Hybrid Courses:** Courses offered in the hybrid format have both a seated, as well as online component to satisfy the requisite class hours. Seated and online hours vary but typically meet as seated hours on alternating weeks. No more than 50% of the coursework is taught online.
