### General Information

The following requirements are preferred of individuals applying to be a Peer Leader for the Shelton Challenge experience:

- Previously attended the Shelton Challenge
- 3.0+ unweighted grade point average (GPA)
- Previous member in Shelton Challenge

### Peer Leader Responsibilities

- To attend at least two staff training sessions (one prior to the week and one day before the participants arrive to the camp).
- To model the five cornerstones of the program – honesty, integrity, compassion, diversity, and social responsibility.
- Each peer leader is assigned to a team for the week. Peer leaders manage their respective teams, ensuring that the curriculum is followed and that each team leaders and followers maximize their opportunities to learn from the experience.
- Peer leaders are responsible for being available to leaders to answer questions and help them process responsibilities they have been assigned to carry out throughout the day. If students have questions, they are to go to the peer leader.
- Peer leaders are expected to assist the institute staff and CMTs in completing their responsibilities as a team. Examples of responsibilities are assisting students assigned as leaders for the day or the activity roles, communicating via hand radio to the Coordinator or Facilitator/ Instructor overseeing student staff, problems, and assisting with communications across teams.
- Peer leaders are expected to communicate with student leaders and coach that person on how to lead the team, while being careful not to tell them what to do or solve their problems for them.
