## With One Simple Crosswalk!

### Transfer Requirements

- 12 transferrable college credits (course level typically 100 or above; must have at least a C in each course), students with fewer than 12 transferrable college credits must apply as a freshman.
- GPA of 2.0 or higher; demonstrate good standing with all post-secondary institutions attended.
- Provide an official transcript from each post-secondary institution attended.
- Students transferring with an AA/AS from the NC Community College System are considered to have met all general education requirements. For students transferring prior to receiving an AA/AS or from schools outside the NCCCS, transcripts will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

Transfer Opportunity (TOA)	\$7,500	2.0-2.4

- 2+ Wesleyan Scholarship - \$2,000  
Must have an associate degree with an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Phi Theta Kappa/Gamma Beta Phi Scholarship - \$1,000  
Must have an associate degree and proof of membership
- United Methodist Scholarship - \$2,000  
Must be a member of the United Methodist Church and submit a letter of reference from pastor
- Transfer scholarships are renewed annually, require full-time enrollment and a GPA of 2.0 or higher in college coursework.
- Additional scholarships may be available. Please review the NCWU website for additional and updated scholarship information.



### Financial Aid

- 100% of Fall 2021 NCWU traditional students received financial aid. Institutional aid is awarded based on academic performance, enrollment classification, housing status and financial need.
- Complete your FAFSA (Free Application for Student Aid) and use school code 002951.
- Military Tuition: All active duty military, veterans, national guard, reserves and their spouses receive 10% off tuition.
