EARLY REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete your Registration with your advisor. Registration is available electronically for Fall 2023. See your academic advisor and/or the Registrar's Office for more details or instructions for how to register for classes.
2. Early registration schedules for Taylor-Crocker Honors Program students, sophomores, juniors and seniors may be completed online according to the following schedule based upon semester hours **successfully completed**:

4. Registration Window and Viewing Your Class Schedule. Students should check my.ncwc.edu (Student Tab – Academic Information – Student Schedule – Fall 2023 - 2024) to review their early registration schedule for Fall 2023 after the registration process has been completed. **Students may complete early registration via the online portal through Friday, May 12, 2023.** Thereafter, students must submit registration materials to the Registrar's Office with the appropriate advisor signature.
5. All May 2023 graduates should carefully review their graduation status with their academic advisor. **The deadline to submit a graduation application for December 2023 degree conferral is Monday, September 18, 2023.** Graduation applications can be accessed through the student portal (my.ncwc.edu). You will also need to indicate at this time whether you intend to participate in the May 2024 commencement ceremony. Applications not submitted by this deadline will incur a late fee. Applications after the final deadline will not be approved for December 2023 degree conferral.

2. Complete payment and/or payment arrangements of any outstanding balance. By registering for classes students request that NCWC apply and hold financial aid in their student account to cover the cost of attendance.

ONLINE COURSES: Traditional students wishing to take a course offered through the Adult Studies and Professional Program must meet the following requirements: **At least 22 years of age; Junior standing; at least a 3.0 GPA.**

The student must choose the traditional class first unless there is a schedule conflict and one of the following conditions applies: (1) The course is a major requirement needed for graduation within the current or pending semester; or (2) The course is a major or minor requirement needed to maintain proper sequencing of major or minor courses. REGISTERING FOR INTERNSHIPS – DOMESTIC/U.S. STUDENTS

To register for a credit-bearing internship, students should first request an appointment with a career advisor by emailing career@ncwc.edu.*

1. Student should complete the NCWU Internship Contract and obtain the signatures of both the site supervisor and faculty sponsor.
2. Student should submit Add/Drop form, Syllabus created by faculty internship sponsor, and Internship Contract to the Provost's Office with all required signatures. The Associate Provost will sign off on approved internships and work to register the students for the internship course with the Registrar's Office. Internship documents received after the add/drop deadline may not be approved.

REGISTERING FOR INTERNSHIPS – STUDENTS STUDYING ON F-1 VISAS

To register for a credit-bearing internship, students should first request an appointment with a career advisor by emailing career@ncwc.edu.*

3. NCWU must approve the internship as meeting U.S. government guidelines for *Curricular Practical Training*. This requires a detailed offer letter from the internship site supervisor.
4. Students should seek clearance from International Student Services before pursuing registration for the internship.
5. To get institutional approval to register for the internship, F-1 visa students must submit an add/drop form, syllabus created by the faculty internship sponsor, the formal offer letter from the internship site, and the NCWU Internship Contract. The Associate Provost will sign off on approved internships that have already been cleared by International Student Services and work to document registration with the ISS Director and the university Registrar.
6. Curricular Practical Training (CPT) internship documentation must be submitted for approval prior to the end of the add/drop period. Late submissions will not be accommodated. The last day to add/drop a class in Fall 2023 is **August 22, 2023**.
